[template("project-logo")]	The "project-logo" merge code will

	Logo . You can change the logo there	
	or by replacing the original file in your	
	library.	
[template("project-name")]	The "project-name" merge code will	
	display the knowledge base name	
	from Settings > Basic .	
[template("contact")]	The "contact" merge code will display	
	a "Contact Us" link to your contact	
	form if you have this feature enabled.	
	You can enable your contact form	
	under Knowledge Base > Contact	
	Form. You can also customize your	
	contact form link or add it to the table	
	of contents.	
[template("searchbar")]	The "searchbar" merge code will	
	display a search bar with the text	
	"Search for articles".	
[template("contents")]		This merge code does not work
