Change icon when you comment

To update your account icon when you're adding a comment:

- 1. Select the comment box to activate the comment form.
- 2. Select the **Update image** link that appears (the wording may vary based on your knowledge base's configuration).
- 3. Browse to the image and open it for upload.
- 4. Submit your comment. The new icon is saved once you submit.

Change author icon

Authors can update their own or other authors' account icon from within app.knowledgeowl.com:

- 1. In KnowledgeOwl, go to Account > Authors.
- 2. Open the author's details.
- 3. In Picture/Icon, select Update.
- 4. Browse to the image and open it for upload.

5. Be sure to **Save** your changes.

Change reader icon

Authors can update readers' account icon from within app.knowledgeowl.com:

- 1. In KnowledgeOwl, go to Account > Readers.
- 2. Open the reader's details.
- 3. In Picture/Icon, select Update.
- 4. Browse to the image and open it for upload.
- 5. Be sure to **Save** your changes.
