

# Make the PDF icon prettier

If you're using the Clayton, Classic, or Modern [themes](#), your PDF icon next to article titles might look like a standard PDF icon, instead of the Font Awesome icon, like this:

You can replace it with a Font Awesome icon that will match the other icons next to the article:

To update your icon to Font Awesome:

1. Go to **Customize > Style (HTML & CSS)**.
2. In the **Customize HTML, CSS, and JS** section, select **Custom HTML**.
3. Select **Article** from the **Select HTML section to edit** dropdown.
4. Copy the code below and paste it into the very bottom of the editor pane:

$(function() {
  $('.hg-article-pdf img').replaceWith('<i class="fa fa-file-pdf-o fa-fw"></i>');
});
</script>
```

5. Be sure to **Save** your changes.
