



Customize category behavior in the table of contents

When a reader clicks on a category in the table of contents, the default behavior is for the category menu to toggle open and closed to show and hide its content.

If you want clicking the category to navigate to the category landing page:

1. Open the category settings. Refer to [Edit a category](#) for more information.
2. Select **Navigate** under the **Table of Contents Options** on the category's settings page:

Table of Contents Options

- ☐ Toggle — Expand or collapse contents when clicked
- ☒ **Navigate** — Go to category page when clicked
- ☐ Hide contents

3. **Optional:** by default, when using the **Navigate** setting, KnowledgeOwl both navigates to the category page on click, and toggles open the category menu. To hide the sub-menu and remove the toggle behavior, select **Hide contents**.
