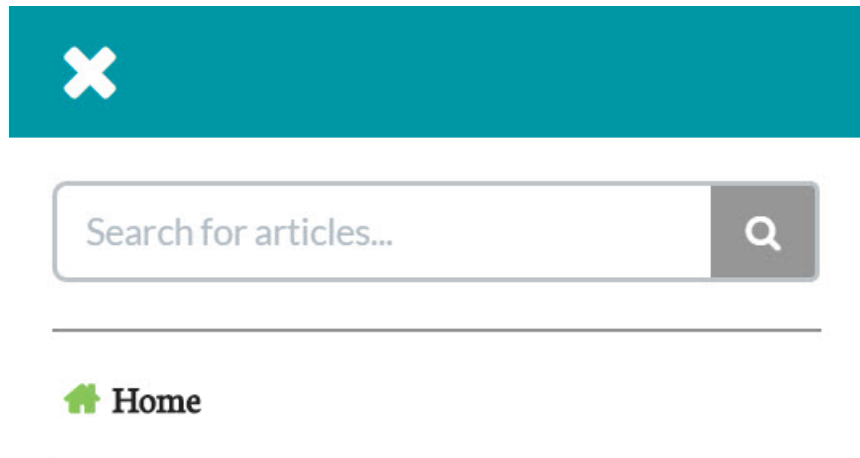




Add search bar to table of contents

Though most themes include a search bar in the top navigation, you might want to include a search bar in your table of contents, as well.



To add a search bar to the top of your table of contents:

1. Go to **Settings > Basic**.
2. In the **Table of contents** section, check the box next to "Add a search bar to the top of the table of contents".
