## Article Editor

To add a related article in the Article Editor:

1. Open the article in edit mode.
2. In the **Related Articles** section, select **Add article**:

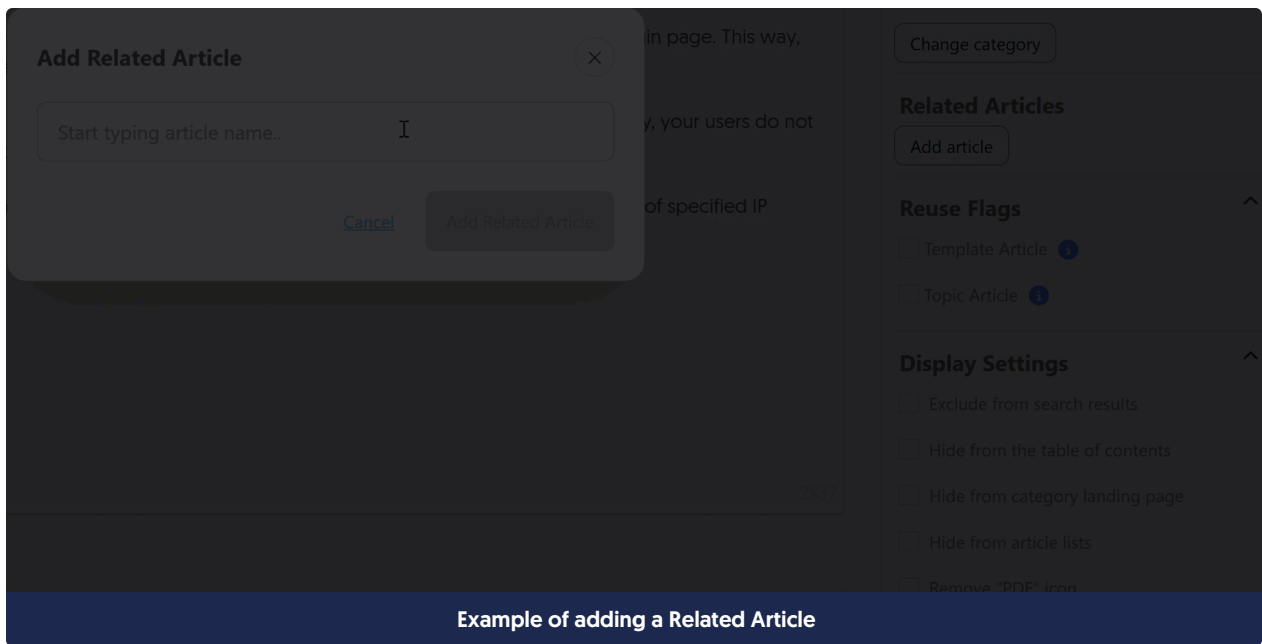

## Category Editor

To add a related article in the Category Editor:


1. Open the category in edit mode.
2. In the **Related Articles** section, select **Add Related Article**:
