



Change the slideout Table of Contents' width (Minimalist Theme)

The Minimalist theme uses a slideout Table of Contents, which is set to 360px by default.

If you'd like to change the width of that Table of Contents:

1. Go to **Settings > Style**.
2. Below the preview pane, select **Custom HTML**.
3. In the Custom HTML dropdown, select **Body**.
4. Copy and paste the code below anywhere into your Body Custom HTML, changing the value="number" to be the pixel width you'd like to use (here, we use 450):

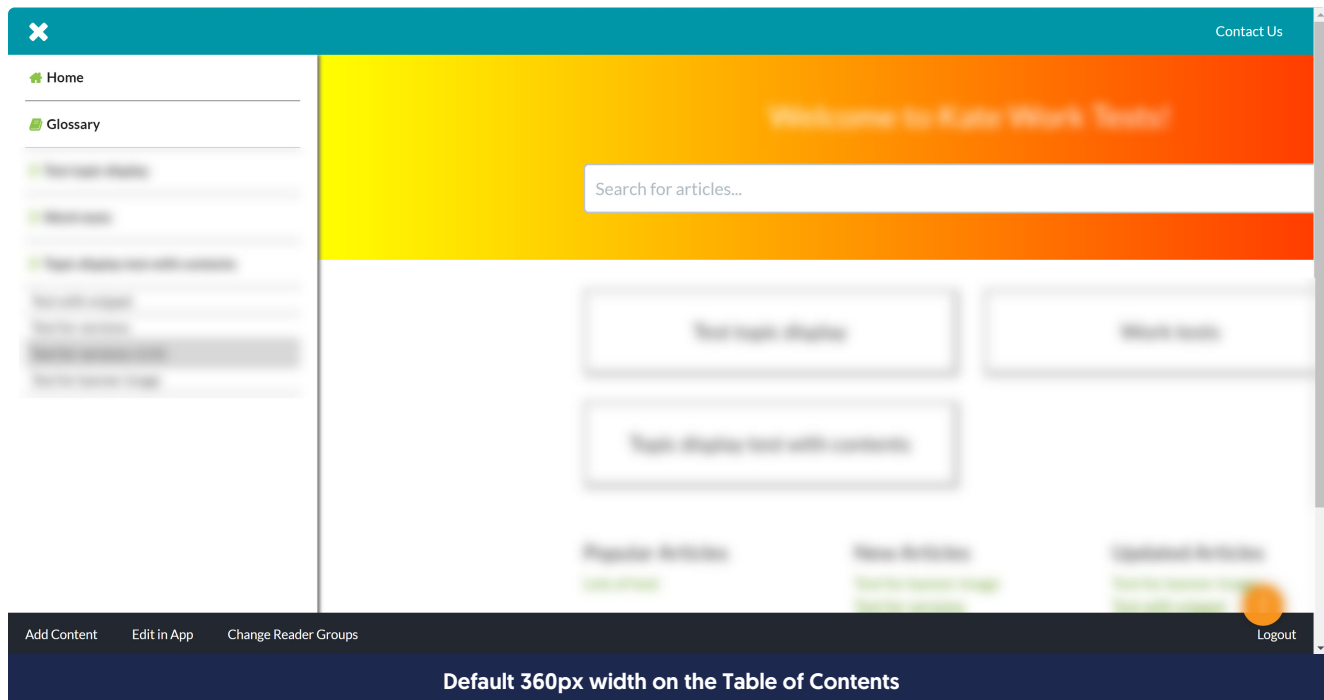
