

## Hide the table of contents

You might want to hide the table of contents completely in your knowledge base--maybe to save some screen real estate, or to force people to work through navigation, or simply because your knowledge base isn't complex enough to need a table of contents everywhere.

To do so, you'll need to use the Single Column layout:

- 1. Go to Settings > Style.
- 2. Expand the Layouts section.
