



Bulk reader import bug fix + new API snippet variable

Two small changes for today:

In the [reader bulk importer](#), we discovered that if you had the same reader name twice, but one of the rows had trailing blank spaces, the bulk reader importer wouldn't identify them as duplicates. It would strip the trailing blank spaces, though, so it created duplicate reader accounts in this situation. We updated the importer so that it trims all blank spaces first before evaluating for duplicates.

If you're using [API calls in snippets](#), we've added a new variable you can use in your API calls: `%cur_search_term%`. It will pull in the "phrase" parameter in the URL. This might be useful for searching a specific category, searching another knowledge base and displaying the results, or building a custom search.
