



Widget 2.0 now supports explicit `https://` and relative `//` URL protocols

When we first built Widget 2.0, we set it up to take a relative URL protocol (beginning with `//`).

We've had a couple customers who needed to be able to explicitly specify this as `https://` in the widget embed code.

We've updated the logic so that it still uses the relative protocol by default but will also accept `https:` added to the start of the `ko19.base_url`.
