



Add or remove the glossary page from your search results

You can control whether your Glossary page shows up in search results when someone searches the word "glossary". When turned on, if a reader searches for the word "glossary" (or whatever name you've renamed your glossary to!), a link to the Glossary displays in a box at the top of your search results:

To turn on this setting:

1. Go to **KB settings > Glossary**. The **Glossary settings** page opens.
2. In the **Display options** section, check the **Search** box to **Display a link to your glossary page when a reader searches for the word "glossary"**.
3. Be sure to **Save** your settings.
