For each version of a custom content category, you can also add Version Notes.

Authors with the default Editor or Writer role can edit custom content category version notes. If you're using a [custom role](#), you'll need to have the **Category Permission to Edit categories** to edit version notes.

This field is a free-form text field. You can use it to add notes about the content, what's changed between versions, or provide editorial feedback to other content authors in the version Note field. Version Notes are only visible in the editor:

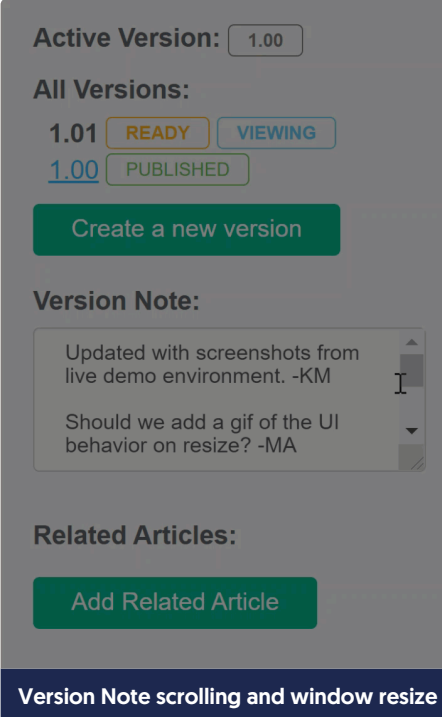
