



Feature update: New, Updated, Popular, and Related Article widget limits now adjustable!

A small but often-requested improvement went out over the weekend:

The ability to change the number of articles automatically displayed in these places:

- [Popular Articles Widget](#)

Previously, we'd set all of these to display 5 articles, if available.

We've now added explicit settings for each of these lists in **Settings > Basic**, so you can choose from 1-10 articles to display here.

For the New, Updated, and Popular Articles Widgets, we've added a new **Article Widget Settings** section:

Article Widget Settings

 Select the maximum number of articles to display in each widget.

Editor Settings

For the **Related Articles**, you can change the number of automatically-displayed articles in the **Website Settings** section:

- SEO Settings**
- Generate a publicly available sitemap
 - Ensure that page titles do not exceed 55 characters
 - 301 redirect URLs ending with a trailing slash to non trailing slash

Website Settings

- Navigation** Enable breadcrumbs
- Top navigation** Add a reader login / logout link
- Related Articles** Automatically suggest related articles based off of the article titles
- Backward suggest articles which list the current article as related
- If both of these options are enabled, the reverse related articles will be ranked higher.
- Limit list to articles
- Glossary Terms** For each glossary term that appears in an article, automatically highlight the term time(s)

Existing behavior for all widgets remains the same; these selectors just let you get more specific about the number of articles displayed.

This has been our most-frequently-requested customization for these lists, and we felt like giving you direct controls over each of them was a much better solution. 😊
