



# Fix error for site owner on Contact Form

## Error text

ERROR for site owner: Invalid domain for site key

## Error location

This error may show up on your live Contact Form just before someone goes to submit to the form. It usually presents right next to the **Back** and **Submit** buttons:

## Cause

This error is a [reCAPTCHA](#) error.

It generally occurs because you have set up a [private domain](#) in KnowledgeOwl, have set your Contact Form to require spam protection, but your knowledge base is set to use reCAPTCHA and you haven't properly added a reCAPTCHA key and secret to **Security and access > Spam protection**.

## Solution
