

New subcategory display option: Icon panels!

Ever since we released the new [icon display option for the homepage](#), we've been so impatient to add icons more places. If you've been impatient, too, then have we got news for you!

We just added a new [Subcategory display option](#) for categories: Icon panels!

Yes, that's right, that icon panel display is here for use in your [Default categories](#).

You'll see the new option in Category Editor whenever you're viewing a Default category:

Once you select Icon panels, an additional set of options will let you limit the maximum number of categories shown and set how many categories you want displayed per row (just like the homepage merge code, but way easier!).

A few other quick notes:
