Want your readers to have quick access to all of their favorites? Add them to your table of contents. This will add a Favorites section to the top of the table of contents, above your content hierarchy, and will display all the articles a reader has favorited (up to 50).

If you have the **KB Settings > Basic** options enabled to add a search bar, homepage link, or glossary link to the table of contents, the Favorites section displays below those:

To add Favorites to your table of contents:

1. Go to **KB settings > Favorites**.
2. Check the box next to **Show article favorites in the table of contents**.
3. Be sure to **Save your changes**.
