



New article archive workflow: redirect the archived article to existing content

The article editor has had an option to [redirect a deleted article to existing content](#) since July of 2021.

With the new changes to the righthand column of the editor, we were able to add in one of my personal long-requested features: the ability to do the same automatic redirect when you archive an article, too. 😊

You'll see the same redirect interface now when you select "Archived" publishing status as you have for "Deleted":
