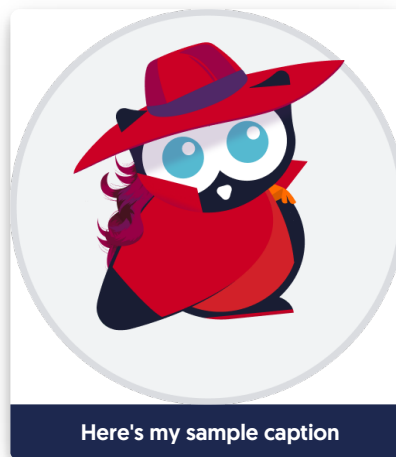


Style image captions

Our default styles will create image captions with a dark grey background and white font. We've styled ours a bit differently to use a dark blue background, like this:



If you'd like to style image captions in your own way:

1. Go to **Customize > Style (HTML & CSS)**.
2. In the **Customize HTML, CSS, and JS** section, select **Custom CSS**.
3. Copy the default CSS below and paste it into your Custom CSS.

  font-weight: initial; /*font bold/not bold*/  
  max-width: 100%; /*How much of the image's width should the caption take up?*/  
  background: #656565; /*Background color for the caption*/  
  border-radius: 0px 0px 4px 4px; /*Border-radius creates rounded corners*/  
  padding: 5px; /*Padding between the text and the edge of the caption*/  
  color: #fff; /*Text color*/  
  line-height: 1.72222; /*Line height*/

4. Adjust the CSS however you see fit. Our most popular customizations are:

- a. **Change the grey background color:** Edit the `background` color in row 6.

b. **Change the color of the caption text:** Edit the `color` in row 9.

5. Be sure to **Save** once you're done making them!
