Suggested content

Use the **Suggested content** settings to control which portion of the URL the widget uses to identify recommended content and whether the widget should "learn" recommended resources based on what end-users on this page ultimately open in the widget.

Recommended tab

Use the settings in this tab to determine the widget's behavior when it only has a single article or category to recommend.

This setting won't impact how the widget makes recommendations overall, but it can open the widget directly to a single page if only one is recommended.
