Beep borp boop! The humans here at KnowledgeOwl are excited to tell you that you can now customize your robots.txt file.

This means you now have the ability to:

- 1. Explicitly allow certain bots or crawlers to crawl your public knowledge base.**  
This is helpful if your public knowledge base is a part of your SEO/AEO/GEO strategy.
- 2. Explicitly prevent certain AI bots or crawlers from crawling your public knowledge base.**  
This is helpful if you want to prevent AI companies from crawling your public knowledge base, and using your content to train their models.

The setting for this lives in **KB settings > Domain**.

There are also options to allow and disallow crawling based on different contexts (like training vs. searching). You can find copyable code samples in the [Customize your robots.txt article](#) based on different scenarios, so you can make these changes without having to think too much about it.
